## ESP Advanced Training Scholarship Application



The \$2,000 ESP Advanced Training Scholarship is presented each year to an Education Support Professional member currently enrolled in training that will advance them in their public education career.

Criteria for the \$2,000 scholarship is as follows: the recipient must be a unified NEOEA member, must be a career ESP in public education, should be in need of financial assistance, and should demonstrate a reasonable prediction of success with this advanced training in a job-related field.

Applicants must be current members of the North Eastern Ohio Education Association.

Current members of the NEOEA Board of Directors are not eligible for this scholarship. In addition, NEOEA Directors are not eligible for two years after completion of service on the Board to apply or to be nominated.

One year after the scholarship is awarded, the recipient shall provide NEOEA with a statement describing his/her employment and the advancement made in their career.

Scholarship must be submitted by Monday, April 15, 2024.
